New Covid 19 Related Policies & Procedures

Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedures:

- Camper drop-off will be staggered between 8:30-9 each morning. GAB Staff will check-in your child at a tent near the front door. Staff will check to make sure all paperwork is complete, do a temperature check and a Covid 19 screening questionnaire. An email will go out each morning for parent's to complete the questionnaire before drop-off. If you forget paper copies will be available.
- Parents are not allowed to linger in the lobby. We need to facilitate a quick drop off process to help maintain physical distancing.
- At pick-up time, remain in your car and a staff member will bring your child and their belongings out to you to sign out.

What each camper needs to bring:

- Campers will need 2-3 face coverings. Face coverings should be labeled with the child's name. They will be required to wear, when physical distancing can not be maintained.
- Campers will need 1 snack if they are half day campers or 2 snacks and a lunch with the necessary utensils if they are full day.
- Campers will need a labeled refillable water bottle. The water fountain is shut-off.
- Campers age 3-6, must bring a change of clothes.

What our staff is doing:

- Staff will follow the illness policy and stay home if they present with any symptoms.
- Staff will wash/sanitize hands frequently.
- Staff will wear masks and adhere to the Board of Health requirements.
- Staff will be trained on all sanitizing and distancing protocols.

How we are preventing the spread:

- Each camp group will remain together but will not be interacting with other camp groups.
- Two health care supervisors will be on-site to help monitor campers and staff.
- If any staff or campers show signs of Covid 19, they will be isolated and sent home as soon as possible
- Facility will continue to be professionally cleaned daily with approved disinfectants and sanitizers.
- Staff will increase their regularity and attention to sanitizing mats & equipment and disinfecting surfaces such as door handles and counters, through out the day.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be located in an increased number of spots throughout the gym.
- Multiple air circulation units that filter out bacteria and viruses will continue to be employed.
- Sanitizing foggers will be deployed at regular intervals while customers aren't present.
